Over 100 teenagers from Vernon Middle School and High School attended "In Her Shoes: Living with Teen Dating Violence", presented by Genesis Women's Shelter & Support. Through this training, students learned about the harsh realities and prevalence of dating violence, and what they can do to empower themselves and their friends.

In the evening, over 50 parents, teachers, and professionals came to hear "Recognizing & Preventing Unhealthy Teen Relationships", presented by Jordyn Lawson. The training focused on what signs may indicate dating violence is occurring, and how to support individuals experiencing it.

\$100,000 State Grant to Fund New Minneapolis-Based Domestic Violence Pilot Program

Australia's Cardinal Pell Sentenced to 6 Years for Sexual Assault

Cardinal George Pell was sentenced to six years in prison by an Australian judge Wednesday for sexually assaulting two boys in the 1990s, making him the most senior Catholic official to be imprisoned in the worldwide wave of abuse that has blighted the church for the past several decades.
