Subletting of Space

Exhibitors may not assign, sublet, or apportion the whole or any part of the space allotted to them without the permission of the conference coordinator.

Care of Exhibit Space

The exhibitors must neatly maintain and keep in good order the exhibit space that they have been assigned. Exhibitors are responsible for supplying their own display boards and or exhibits. The Conference on Crimes Against Women ("CCAW") will provide 6' skirted tables in line with the size of exhibit space purchased.

Electrical

Electrical outlets are available to exhibitors for light duty use. Exhibitors must bring their own electrical extension cords for use in the event there is no wall outlet at their location. Electrical extension cords may be obtained from the hotel for a fee for which exhibitor will be responsible. Electric power use for the week is an additional \$75. Any additional audio/visual needs must also be obtained through the hotel at the exhibitor's expense.

Internet Access

Standard wireless Internet access is available from the hotel for a fee of \$150 per exhibit booth, regardless of the number of computers connected. Ethernet Internet access is also available for an additional fee of \$25 per computer connection. Exhibitors needing Ethernet Internet access should contact the Sheraton Hotel at 214-922-8000 **no later than February 15, 2012.**

Space Limitations

Exhibitors will be confined to the limits of the respective space(s). All materials must conform to applicable local building, electrical, fire and safety, and other regulations.
